

What is the general daily routine for feeding and turnout?



- ALL HORSES FOLLOW A ROUTINE AT WAREDACA:
- MORNING FEEDING BETWEEN 7 AND 8 AM
- EVENING FEEDING 3:30 AND 5:00
- STALL BOARDED HORSES ARE TURNED IN AND OUT AS A GROUP AT THEIR RESPECTIVE STALL SITES. MARES AND GELDINGS ARE IN SEPARATE AREAS
- SEASONAL ALTERNATION OF AM/PM TURNOUT
- A BLANKET POLICY EXISTS FOR STALL BOARDED HORSES
- WE FEED PURINA PRODUCTS; NUTRITIONAL INFORMATION AVAILABLE ON THE PURINA WEBSITE.

What do I do before I leave for travel out of town?

- LEAVE EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION WITH OUR STAFF PREFERABLY WITH AN EMAIL: GRETCHEN@WAREDACA.COM

Is the cross-country course always available for boarders to school?

- THE ENTIRE COURSE IS CLOSED SEVERAL WEEKS PRIOR TO THE EVENT, MAINLY FOR THE FOOTING—TAKE OFF AND LANDING AREAS TO BE RESTED AND THEN PREPARED
- EVERYONE MUST WEAR A PROTECTIVE HELMET AND VEST AND HAVE GROUNDS PERSON WITH THEM

When is the veterinarian scheduled to come and do shots and deworming? What if my horse gets injured and needs vet attention?

- ALL THE HORSES WHO LIVE ON THE FARM BE ON THE SAME ROUTINE
- EVERY HORSE IS INCLUDED IN THE HEALTH CARE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM—WORMING AND VACCINATIONS AND IS GENERALLY SCHEDULED EVERY 6-8 WEEK. DAMASCUS EQUINE ASSOCIATES/DR. SCULLIN CONDUCTS THIS SERVICE AND WILL DO DIRECT BILLING THROUGH HIS OFFICE.
- NOTIFY STAFF AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE IF YOUR HORSE NEEDS TO BE SEEN BY THE VET.
- CHECK WITH THE BARN MANAGER AS TO WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS DIRECTIONS
- OUR BARN MANAGERS PROXY ALL VET VISITS AND UPDATE OWNERS AFTERWARDS. YOU ARE CERTAINLY WELCOME TO BE PRESENT WHEN THE VET EXAMINES YOUR HORSE.
- IF YOU CHOOSE TO USE A DIFFERENT VET, IT REMAINS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE THOSE ARRANGMENTS AND FOLLOW THRU ON YOUR HORSE BEING SEEN AND THE DETAILS OF THAT VISIT SHARED WITH OUR STAFF FOR CONTINUITY OF CARE FOR YOUR HORSE

Is my dog welcome to come to the farm?

- DOGS ARE WELCOME AT WAREDACA IF WELL BEHAVED AND PROPERLY SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES
- BE MINDFUL THAT FAMILY DOGS DO LIVE AT WAREDACA AND CONSIDER THE FARM THEIR 'HOME'.
- **OUR DOG POLICY COVERS SPECIFIC DETAILS AND IS ONE OF THE BOARDER DOCUMENTS TO BE COMPLETED AND ON FILE**

When does the farrier come? Can I use a different farrier than the one who comes to Waredaca regularly?

- ALPHA OMEGA FARRIERS VISIT WAREDACA WEEKLY
- FOLLOWING AN INITIAL VISIT, YOUR HORSES NAME WILL BE ON THEIR LIST EVERY 4-8 WEEKS FOR ROUTINE CARE;
- YOU DO NOT NEED TO BE PRESENT
- IF YOU CHOOSE TO USE YOUR OWN FARRIER, MAKE THOSE ARRANGMENTS YOURSELF-YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE VISITATION. CHECK WITH STAFF RE DAY AND TIME AS TO AVAILABLE WORKSPACE AREA

- **grooming functions**--mane and tail pulling, sheath cleaning, clipping, bathing
- **exercising and/or training** of your horse for you. Our capable staff can assist you with any mounted or unmounted concerns.
